



The Governor's Office of Highway Safety is committed to making Arizona's roadways safer by promoting and coordinating programs that influence public and private policy and increase awareness about highway safety issues. We are dedicated to promoting seat belt use, protecting children, educating motorists, motorcycle riders, bicyclists and pedestrians about traffic safety and eliminating impaired driving, increasing seatbelt usage and reducing traffic-related deaths and injuries.

GOHS provides federal funds to state, local and tribal agencies, and community partners, to assist in enforcement and educational activities around Arizona. Our efforts and your awareness reduced Arizona highway fatalities by 18 percent in 2007, meaning 227 fewer people killed on our roadways, including a reduction of 7 motorcycle rider fatalities.
