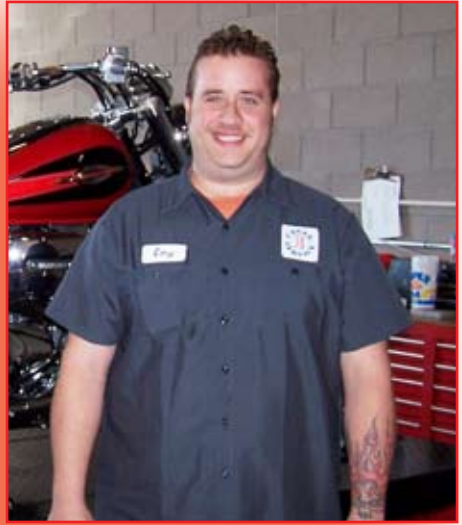


Motorcycle Tech Tip

Tips on Storing
Your Motorcycle

We at JB Mobile Cycle Service would like to talk about storing your motorcycle. I can't tell you how many times I've been called to someone's house for a dead battery. Not starting your motorcycle at least once a month will cause your battery to loose charge. Installing a small battery tender that plugs into the wall and keeps your battery maintained will keep your battery healthy for years. Fuel is another thing that will make it hard to start your motorcycle after sitting for a couple months. Again, we recommend that you start your motorcycle at least once a month to prevent clogging of injectors/carbs. Another thing you can do is put a fuel stabilizer in your tank to prevent the gas from going bad. If you are going to be storing your motorcycle for a long time, I recommend that you drain all the fuel out of your motorcycle. These helpful hints will keep your motorcycle running great for a long time.
